Dear Students and Parents:

In keeping with our long history of community service and our mission to provide unity and goodwill, the Willing Workers Ladies Aid, Inc. sponsors the **Gallatin Gateway Student Scholarship Program**. The program assists students who wish to pursue post-secondary education (college/university, community college, trade school) and may need some financial assistance. Students already enrolled in post-secondary institutions who meet our eligibility requirements are also welcome to apply. Fund-raisers and donations support the scholarship program. We are pleased to offer scholarships to students within our supportive Gallatin Gateway community and are proud of the program's success.

Students who wish to be considered for an award must have received elementary education in the Gallatin Gateway area (Gallatin Gateway School, home school, etc.), and submit the following to WWLA.

1. Completed Application Form. The form is available on the Gallatin Gateway Community Center website: www.gallatingatewaycommunitycenter.com
2. A letter including:
 - reason the applicant wishes consideration
 - description of unpaid community service performed by the applicant, done prior to submission of the application. Opportunities for community service are available at R.S.V.P. Southwest Montana: www.rsvpmt.org or phone: 587-5444
 - statement of the applicant's perceived financial need
3. A letter of recommendation from a responsible adult, e.g., teacher, counselor, high school administrator, minister
4. For high school students, a copy of the applicant's most recent high school transcript is required. For applicants already enrolled in an institution of post-secondary education, a copy of the most recent college transcript is required. For those who have completed a GED program, a copy of the GED certificate is required.
5. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the educational institution for the upcoming term

Items 1-4 MUST be received by WWLA by April 15 to be considered for a fall term award. Since the applicant's letter of acceptance (item 5) may not be available until after the deadline, this item may be submitted later. However, funds will not be released until all the application materials have been received.

Scholarship disbursements will be made directly to the educational institution's registrar in the student's name. Please contact Lain Kay if you have questions about our program or its requirements.
